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PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, production and inventory control management is an important adjunct to any industry as it exercises continuous control over all phases of material flow both into and out of each manufacturing concern; and
- WHEREAS, production and inventory control management enables manufacturers to establish smooth working relationships with producers and distributors of their own products; and
- WHEREAS, the American Production and Inventory Control Society, Inc., was organized in 1957 and has grown to over 8,500 members in over 127 chapters throughout the United States, one territory, and ten international affiliations; and
- WHEREAS, the primary objectives of this international professional society are to develop professional efficiency in production and inventory management through study, research, and application of scientific methods and thereby advance the general welfare of the industrial economy; and
- WHEREAS, the National-International Organization has scheduled its 14th Annual International Conference and Technical Exhibit at St. Louis, Missouri on November 3, 4, and 5, 1971, at which time the International President, Mr. Arthur Bates, will take occasion to stress the fact that for the third time in its history APICS is being officially honored by the issuance of this proclamation; and
- WHEREAS, the week of November 1, 1971 has been officially designated as National American Production and Inventory Control Week in recognition of this important segment of industry;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 1-5, 1971 as

NATIONAL AMERICAN PRODUCTION AND INVENTORY CONTROL WEEK

in the State of Minnesota, and I encourage industries in Minnesota to avail themselves of the consultation and information service provided by the American Production and Inventory Control Society, Inc.
