PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, services provided by Public Works Departments throughout the State of Minnesota are a vital part of our citizens' everyday life; and

WHEREAS, the cooperation and support of an informed citizenry is important to the planning and implementation of public works programs and activities; and

WHEREAS, the health, safety, and general well being of this state and its counties and cities are dependent to a large degree on the quality, efficiency and effectiveness of the facilities and services provided by our various Public Works Divisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 9 through May 13, 1971, as

NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK

and call upon all citizens to acquaint themselves with public works facilities and services, and recognize the important role played by the various Public Works Departments in our state.
