PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The Shriners Hospitals for Crippled Children and Burns Inpatients, which are dedicated to the total care and treatment of all children regardless of race, creed, or color; and

WHEREAS, this year marks the 49th Anniversary of the first such hospital started by the Ancestral Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine; and

WHEREAS, during the past 49 years the Shriners Hospitals have cured or materially helped more than 100,000 children; and

WHEREAS, The Shriners Hospitals for Crippled Children and Burns Inpatients deserve the appreciation of every resident in the State of Minnesota for their great humanitarian work;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, May 16, 1971, as

INTERNATIONAL SHRINE HOSPITAL DAY

in the State of Minnesota, and ask that all citizens join me in paying tribute to the Shrine of North America.
