PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, well over ten million people in the United States now enjoy the healthful recreation and sportmanship of the Game of Golf; and

WHEREAS, The Professional Golfers' Association of America will sponsor the twentieth Annual NATIONAL GOLF DAY on Monday, May 31, 1971; and

WHEREAS, during the last nineteen years, over \$1,500,000.00 has been realized from NATIONAL GOLF DAY for United Service Organizations, the American Red Cross, Gaddis Scholarship Fund, the U. S. Blind Golfers Association, the National Amateur Golf Association, the Jaycee War Memorial Fund, Golf Facilities at Veterans' Hospitals and Military Installations, Golf Research and Education, Golf Professional Education, financial assistance to those in special circumstances who have devoted their lives to Golf; and

WHEREAS, this day in 1971 will offer all the Golfers of America an opportunity to again assist many of these worthy charities and projects, as well as an opportunity to compete against the Men's and Ladies' PGA Champions, and USGA Open Champions.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, May 31, 1971, as

GOLF DAY

in the State of Minnesota and urge all the Golfers of our State to cooperate in this worthy public venture by playing a round of Golf, thereby contributing to the many deserving charities and projects associated with this great Game.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-eighth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and of the State, the one hundred thirtieth.
