WHEREAS, the Young World Development program of the American Freedom From Hunger Foundation, through the Walk For Development and other activities, accomplishes a positive and constructive youth effort to solve the problems of poverty and hunger in the United States and the world; and

WHEREAS, American youth in more than 350 cities will, during the month of May, 1971, join with youth in 40 other countries participating in an International Walk For Development to show their commitment to efforts that will allow poor and hungry people throughout the world the opportunity to overcome their poverty and hunger and efforts that help promote peaceful economic development of underdeveloped areas in hopes of bridging the gap between rich and poor countries to promote economic justice and world peace; and

WHEREAS, thousands of youth in many communities in Minnesota are planning for local participation in this international demonstration of concern for the world's poor and hungry;

Now, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May 1971, as
