KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WARREN SPANNAUS, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes, Section 8.06, and upon the request of the Commissioner of Highways, do hereby constitute and appoint

of Saint Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General and fix his compensation in the sum of Ten Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$10,500) per annum, to be paid from and out of the Trunk Highway Funds.
