

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BARNESVILLE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED BY AND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE CITY.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARNESVILLE DOES ORDAIN:

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the city at the west boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban in character; and

WHEREAS, this territory is owned in fee by the city; the city council of Barnesville, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City of Barnesville, Minnesota are hereby extended to include the unplatted property described as follows now owned by the City of Barnesville in the County of Clay, State of Minnesota, to-wit:

The East Half of the Southwest Quarter
(E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-five (25)
Township One Hundred Thirty-Seven (137),
Range Forty-Six (46).

Section 2. Filing. The city clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the County in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of Certified copies as directed in Section 2.
