ORDINANCE NO. 2.04

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN UNPLATTED
LANDS IN SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 119 North,
RANGE 33 West

The Village Council of the Village of Atwater does
ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Origination and Procedure. The owner of certain unincorporated and unplatted land contiguous to the Village of Atwater petitioned for annexation pursuant to Section 414.033, Subdv. 5, of Minnesota Statutes, which permits a property owner of unplatted land not exceeding 200 acres to petition the governing body of a municipality to have said land included within said municipality. Such petition was filed with the Village Council of Atwater on the 4th day of November, 1970, and thereafter copies of said petition were filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Genessee Town Board and Kandiyohi County Board of Commissioners. There being no written objections to the annexation from either the affected Town Board or the Village Council within the time specified, the Village Council thereafter determined that the annexation would be in the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected. This annexation proceeding shall be deemed final upon the filing of a copy of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Kandiyohi County Auditor, the Secretary of State for the State of Minnesota, and the Genessee Town Board Clerk.

SECTION 2. Description. Lands subject to this annexation are in the Township of Genessee, County of Kandiyohi, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the North Half of the Southeast Quarter (N 1/2 of SE 1/4) of Section Eleven (11), Township One Hundred Nineteen (119) North, Range Thirty Three (33) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot Seven (7) of Block Four (4) in Eroberg's Addition to the Village of Atwater; thence running Westerly on and along the Southerly boundary line of said Lot Seven (7) produced a distance of 70 feet; thence running Northerly parallel with the Westerly boundary line of said Block Four (4) a distance of 81.5 feet to the point of beginning of the tract herein described; thence from said point of beginning continuing Northerly parallel with said Westerly boundary line a distance of 218.5 feet to its intersection with the Southerly boundary line of Montana Avenue; thence bearing South 85° 06' West on and along the Southerly boundary line of Montana Avenue a distance of 478 feet; thence bearing South 44° 03' 30" West a distance of 332.77 feet to a point that is 218.5 feet Southerly of the Southerly boundary line of Montana Avenue, as measured perpendicular thereto; thence bearing North 85° 06' East parallel with the Southerly boundary line of Montana Avenue a distance of 729.91 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 3 acres more or less.

SECTION 3. Annexation. That the said property is hereby annexed to, and included within, the Village of Aewater, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part hereof.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance is deemed to be in full force and effect from and after its date of publication.
