PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The State of Minnesota wishes to ensure the quality of its environment for this and future generations; and

WHEREAS, Motor is a health and safety hazard and destroys the natural beauty of our state; and

WHEREAS, as part of their continuing effort to end the land pollution caused by littering, the City Council of Ancker and Rose Ancker Bursick, Inc., are operating a nationwide litter cleanup program on June 5, 1971, to give the environment a special cleanup;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 5, 1971, as

CLEANUP YOUR AREA! NATIONAL DAY

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens of the State of Minnesota, young and old, to take part in this program and to make litter prevention a daily habit from this date forward.
