PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The Salvation Army has rendered devoted services to God and man for over 100 years, and has ministered to the spiritual and material needs of the people of Minnesota since 1869; and

WHEREAS, The Salvation Army, since its founding, has considered all men to be children of God who recognize no distinction of color, creed, or national origin among His own; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of May 10-16, 1971 as

"SALVATION ARMY WEEK"

in Minnesota and do urge all citizens to join me in honoring the dedicated and conspicuous services of the Salvation Army and its workers throughout Minnesota.

BY VERMONT WINTER, I have heretofore set by law and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed to the State Capitol this seventh day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and of the State, the one hundred thirtieth.
