WHEREAS, the youth of this state constitute its most precious resource; and

WHEREAS, the critical significance of the care and experience of children from infancy through their early school years to successfully recognized; and

WHEREAS, by birth every child in this nation is entitled:

To love, security and encouragement from a stable home;

To health and nutritional services to insure his optimal physical and mental development;

To protection from physical dangers and social hazards by a community which plans for its children's needs;

To programs which stimulate and motivate children's full and meaningful development—which build on children's interest to experiment and discover things about themselves, other people and the ever broadening world they never

To concern, orientation and guidance from all adults in their lives—such parents, their teachers and others competent, dedicated and supportive in their roles.

LET IT THEREFORE BE HEREBY PROCLAIMED MAY 16-22, 1971, as

"THE WEEK OF THE YOUNG CHILD"

IN REMEMBRANCE AND HONOR OF CHILDREN TO WHOM MIGHT OFFERED TO THEM AGAIN
YOUTH CHILDREN AND PROJECTS WORKING SINCE.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twentieth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and of the State, the one hundred thirtieth.
