PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, This right has been solemnly guarded by the Realtors of Minnesota, who have contributed toward public confidence in real estate ownership by their pledge to uphold the rigid Code of Ethics of the National Association of Real Estate Boards; and,

WHEREAS, The citizens of our state have benefited in countless ways from the efforts of Realtors in civic affairs, for charitable causes, and, most important, in the promotion of their professional knowledge of real estate matters for the good of our communities and our state; and

WHEREAS, Realtors by the very nature of their profession wield great responsibility to, and influence on, the success and health of home and community; and,

WHEREAS, Realtors have assumed this responsibility with credit, by encouraging wise utilization of land, by advocating programs fostering home ownership, by solving problems in our cities, towns, and our environment through the activities of their broad Lake America Dettar Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 23 through May 29, 1971, to be
