WHEREAS, the Miss Minnesota Pageant for the selection of Miss Minnesota has been held in Austin, Minnesota for the past five years, and

WHEREAS, the Miss Minnesota Corporation and the Austin Jaycees have established the dates of June 14 through June 19, 1971 as the dates for holding the 1971 Miss Minnesota Pageant which will be held in Austin, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the 1969 Minnesota Legislature by consensus resolution has formally established this annual pageant established in 1935 by designating the reigning Miss Minnesota, Miss Juliana G. Gher and her successors to be selected in the future, as the official Miss Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that said pageant receive the utmost public support and recognition throughout the State of Minnesota,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 14 through June 19, 1971, as

"MISS MINNESOTA WEEK"

throughout the State of Minnesota.
