PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The National Catholic Society of Roscommon, a fraternal benefit society which operates in nineteen of the Fifty United States, and Canada, organized for the purpose of : (a) to promote friendship, unity and true Catholic charity among its members; (b) foster fraternal and benevolent activities to the sick, disabled and needy members and their families; (c) conducting parochial aid through a sound insurance program to the members, their families and beneficiaries of members and their families; (d) further the programs of the Catholic Church, and (e) promote Patriotic love and loyalty to our Country, and are active in community undertaking for the betterment of public health and the general welfare of the people, and

WHEREAS, This proclamation is calling attention and leaders within the church and local parishes, that comprise the Minnesota Antislavery, of the National Catholic Society of Roscommon, a fraternal benefit society, to unite in the promotion of the observance of the 100th anniversary, in order that all the people of this state may be fully apprised of the ideals and purposes of said National Catholic Society of Roscommon, a fraternal benefit society, and

WHEREAS, The National Catholic Society of Roscommon, will give special observance on July 17, 1971, with appropriate ceremonies celebrating the 100th anniversary, since its founding in 1891, to include this day as a fitting one to honor the founders of our society, and to proclaim their innocent heritage.

Now, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 17, 1971, as

"THE NATIONAL CATHOLIC SOCIETY OF ROSCOMMON DAY"

And I, as Governor of this State, invite the people to lend their support by attending the National Catholic Society of Roscommon functions open to the public during said day that they may become aware of the splendid ideals and purposes of this society.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one and of the State the one hundred fourteenth.
