- WHEREAS, Minnesota has long enjoyed a reputation among travelers for its friendliness and courtesy; and
- WHEREAS, the Society of American Travel Writers is conducting its fourth annual national Welcome a Visitor observance during the period of June 14-20, 1971; and
- WHEREAS, President Nixon has asked for the support and encouragement of all Americans for this program; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim June 14-20, 1971 as

"WELCOME A VISITOR TO MINNESOTA OBSERVANCE"
