The undersigned, all residents and legal voters of the territory hereinafter described, being desirous of having said territory incorporated as a Village, and separated from Town of silver for all purposes as provided by Chapter Nine, General Statutes of Minnesota, 1913, and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, respectfully show and petition your Monorable body as follow:

Enat a censue was duly taken of all of the resident population in sald territory hereinafter described, so proposed to be incorporated into a Village, he tween the 20th. day of February, and the 24th. day of February, 1921, and that the actual resident population of said territory as shown by said census was One Hundred Eighty (180) residents.

That the name of such proposed Willage shall be "Kettle River".

That the area and boundaries of said proposed Village shall be as follows:
