of Rosemount, Minnesota, Special Assistant Attorney General, and fix his compensation in the sum of Thirteen Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$13,500) per annum, to be paid from and out of the Trunk Highway Fund. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 30th day of June, 1971.
