Waseca do hereby certify:


That the Village of Waldorf in the County of Waseca and
State of Minnesota is a duly organized and incorporated village
under the laws of the State of Minnesota, to which the provisions of
section 1333 General Statutes of the State of Minnesota for the year
1915 applied.

That pursuant to said sections 1333 & 1315, a special
election, called for the purpose of submitting the question whether
said Village of Waldorf should constitute a separate election and
assessment District was duly held in said Village of Waldorf on
the 20th day of April A D 1921.

That the result of said vote at such election was duly
certified by the judges thereof to the Village Council of such Village
and by said Village Council to the County Auditor of said Waseca
County and it appearing from such certificate that the vote
at said special election was favorable to constituting said Village
of Waldorf a separate election and assessment District,

Therefore I Theodore Peterson County Auditor of said
Waseca County do hereby certify such fact to the Secretary of State
of the State of Minnesota, all as provided in and required by said
section 1333 General Statutes of the State of Minnesota for the year 1915.
