## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS,

essential legislation to provide for the operation of State Government in Minnesota for the next biennium has not been acted upon by the Legislature; and,

WHEREAS,

the time permitted by law for passage of such legislation during the Sixty-Seventh Session of the Legislature has expired and an extraordinary occasion is therefore created;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby summon you, the members of the Legislature, to convene in Extra Session on Tuesday, May 25, 1971, at 10 o'clock in the morning on that day at the Capitol in St. Paul, Minnesota.

It is my earnest request that only major legislation to serve the needs of the people of Minnesota be considered in this Extra Session and that the Legislature conclude its work as quickly as possible. Clearly the passage of tax and finance legislation that will substantially reduce the property taxes of citizens throughout the state is of first importance.
