ORDINANCE NO. 58.

An ordinance submitting the question to a vote of the electors of the City of East Grand Forks, Polk County, Minn. whether said city shall become incorporated under and subject to the provisions of chapter eight (8) of the general laws of 1895, entitled "An act to provide for the incorporating, organization and government of cities", upon the petition to the city council of more than one-eighth of the voters of said city voting at the last election of said city.

The city council of the city of East Grand Forks, Minn. do ordain as follows :

Sec. 1: That the question of the incorporation and reorganization of the City of East Grand Forks, Polk County, Minn. under and subject to the provisions of chapter eight (8) of the general laws of the state of Minnesota for the year 1895, entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation, organization and government of cities", be submitted to a vote of the electors of said city for adoption or rejection.

Sec. 2: That, there being no regular election to occur in the city of East Grand Forks within ninety days after this date, that a special election be held in said city on Thursday, September 1st, 1898 at which time the question of reorganization of said city of East Grand Forks under the provisions of said act will be submitted to the electors of said city for their acceptance or rejection, and that the city recorder give due notice that the said question will be submitted to the electors of said city at said time by posting five (5) copies thereof in each ward of said city and by publishing the same in the official paper of said city at least thirty days before said election.

Sec. 3: This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
