- WHEREAS: the art of Mason Twirling is today the second largest nationwide recreational youth movement for girls, and
- WHEREAS: Mason Twirling plays an important part in children's hospitals as a unique and effective method of physical therapy, and
- WHEREAS: Mason Twirlers lend a touch color and inspiration to our community celebrations, parades, school events and other activities, and
- WHEREAS: Champion twirlers from all over the United States will gather at the University of Notre Dame in August to conduct a colorful youth program called "Mason's Youth on Parade";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of August 1 - 7, 1971 as

"NATIONAL MASON TWIRLING WEEK"

and do urge our citizens to support the colorful and benevolent Youth Movement of Mason Twirling, which is of such importance to the youth of our state and to youth everywhere.
