PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: the family is the fundamental unit of our democratic society and the prime source of the love and affection necessary for the development of mature individuals, and

WHEREAS: the recognition of the family unit is a continuing aim of the United States Government, and

WHEREAS: to Americans for generations, the love of home and family has been a source of the deepest, most intense spiritual strength, and

WHEREAS: the ALL-AMERICAN FAMILY SEARCH seeks recognition for families in which the members are bound closely by ties of affection and by sharing of activities, families which are strong and united yet allow each member the freedom to develop his potential as a person and a citizen of the community, and families which prepare children to take their proper place in life as mature adults and responsible citizens, and

WHEREAS: the celebration of the 1971-1972 ALL-AMERICAN WEEK will take place during the ALL-AMERICAN FAMILY PROGRAM and CONFERENCE at Lehigh Acres, Florida, August 9 - 14, 1971, and

NOW, WHEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 9 - 14, 1971 as

"ALL-AMERICAN FAMILY WEEK"

in Minnesota.
