### PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS: the needs arises, both at home and abroad, to attend to the well-being of forgotten peoples, and
- WHEREAS: the President of the United States, Richard M. Nixon, has urged a greater dedication to citizen volunteerism as a means to bring about the well-being of these peoples, and
- WHEREAS: the President has caused to be created a new federal organization to consolidate formerly separate government volunteer opportunities, and
- WHEREAS: this new agency has been openly designated "VOLUNTEER," and
- WHEREAS: this agency will bring to the coming decade, domestically and internationally, the social action so in keeping with the dignity of all peoples;

Now, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 9 - 14, 1971 as

#### "ACTION WEEK"

and do encourage all citizens to be cognizant of the greater opportunity now at hand to promote their convictions of the dignity of all mankind into actions.

IN WITNESS WHEREBY, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this tenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and of the State the one hundred and fourteenth.
