- WHEREAS: the Mrs. Jaycees of Minnesota are supporting the National Home of Hope program by participating on a statewide basis in order to raise the funds to donate and more within the STATE TREASURY for the retarded,

NOW, WHEREFORE, I, Wendell P. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 22, 1971 to be
