DECLARATIONS

- WHEREAS: Hunger is worldwide and the death of people and is caused by the national contribution of technology; and
- WHEREAS: the food of Washington, however, is not known to all countries, nor to the minds of the world's population; and
- WHEREAS: World for Millions, a non-governmental organization, is currently utilizing free enterprise methods to help starving people throughout the world find themselves on a self-sustaining basis; and
- WHEREAS: this organization does develop countries but to wealth, progress and distribute their own high profits back using their own resources, capital and expertise; and
- WHEREAS: a widespread educational program has been initiated by World for Millions utilizing the assistance of civic, educational, medical and religious leaders within a country to encourage the use of the multi-purpose funds in schools, hospitals and organizations as well as through annual commercial market donations; and
- WHEREAS: World for Millions' educational program of self-help for the starving people of our globe is one of the finest examples in the humanitarian field of international progress;

AND, WHEREAS, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of December, 1971, as

"MONTH FOR MILLIONS INTERNATIONAL MONTH"

in the State of Minnesota.

ON BEHALF OF SENATE, I have herewith set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this thirteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one and of the State the one hundred twentieth.
