PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: there are in the United States as many as one-half a million children with some form of growth deviation, and,

WHEREAS: medical science is conducting pioneer research into the humanitarian correction of these problems, and,

WHEREAS: there are many children in Minnesota who are victims of these disorders, and,

WHEREAS: the Human Growth Foundation, a non-profit voluntary organization has been established to serve this area by providing information on genetic problems; assistance to families in need of moral encouragement, medical aid or financial assistance; for collection of the human pituitary glands, source of human growth hormone and erection and support of medical research, testing and treatment programs concerning human growth and its deviations.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby designate September 11 through 10, 1971, as

"NATIONAL HUMAN GROWTH WEEK"

in Minnesota and urge my fellow citizens to assist and support this great humanitarian cause.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this third day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and of the State, the one hundred fourteenth.
