PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: the President's Council on Physical Fitness stresses the continued importance and necessity of building strength, stamina and endurance in our nation's youth by emphasizing daily vigorous exercise, and,

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota in cooperation with the Ford Dealers of Minnesota and the Minnesota Vikings has undertaken to sponsor local Punt, Pass and Kick Competition for boys between the ages of eight and thirteen, and,

WHEREAS: Punt, Pass and Kick offers young boys an opportunity to compete in a national program which underlines the importance of physical conditioning basic to other forms of excellence, and at the same time allows for supervised participation in a competitive sports situation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1971, as

"PUNT, PASS AND KICK MONTH"

and urge all citizens to observe the month with the traditional American spirit of competition and good sportsmanship.
