PROCLAMATION

during the past year preventable fires have taken ninety (90) lives and injured hundreds in Winnesota; WHEREAS:

destruction of property by fire resulted in an annual loss of nearly thirty-two million dollars, numerous WHEREAS: jobs, and of an irreplaceable amount of production;

WHEREAS: safety of life and property and conservation of natural resources are of great importance to every citizen of Minnesota; and

the effectiveness of sound fire prevention programs has been demonstrated in communities throughout the land; WHEREAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Covernor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 3rd through October 9th, 1971, as

"FIRE PREVENTION WEEK"

and call upon all citizens to initiate a year-round campaign against the waste caused by preventable fires, and I urgo the Chamber of Commerce, business, labor and farm organizations, as well as schools, civic groups, and public information agencies, to cooperate in the observances of "Fire Prevention Week."
