## AN ORDINANCE

Adopting as a part of the City Charter of the City of Lake City, an act of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, entitled an act "To grant additional powers to the cities of the state of Minnesota, and to empower such cities to issue their bonds for certain purposes therein mentioned;" approved April 12th, 1893, known as H. F. No. 48, making said city subject to the provisions thereof.

The Common Council of the City of Lake City do ordain:

SECTION 1. An act of the legislature of the state of Minnesota entitled "An act to grant additional powers to the cities of the state of Minnesota and to empower such cities to issue their bonds for certain purposes therein mentioned," approved April 12, 1893, known as H. F. No. 48, is hereby adopted as an addition to and part of the charter of said city of Lake City, and is hereby made subject to all the provisions of said act.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication. Passed April 27, 1893.
