Certificate of Result of Special Election in Thief River Falls.

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Polk County, in the State of Minnesota, duly held on the 15th day of September, A. D. 1896, for the purpose of canvassing the returns of an election held on September 1st, A. D. 1896, pursuant to and in accordance with an order of this Board made and filed on the 25th day of July, A. D. 1896, for the purpose of voting upon a proposition to create, organize, and incorporate contiguous territory, which was not organized as a city, and had a population of more than Eleven Hundred and less than Two Thousand inhabitants, lying and being in the County of Polk, and State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

Section numbered thirty-three (33) now incorporated and known as the Village of Thief River Falls; Lot numbered Five (5) of Section Twenty-seven (27); the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of the Northwest quarter (NW 1/4) and the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) and West half (W 1/2) of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) and Lots Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5) and Six (6) of Section numbered Thirty-four and Lot One (1) of Section Thirty-five (35) all in Township numbered One Hundred and Fifty-four (154) North, of Range numbered Forty-three (43) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, as a city under and in pursuance of Chapter 3 of the General Laws of 1895 of the State of Minnesota, and that the Corporate name thereof be Twin Falls or Thief River Falls, we, the said Board of County Commissioners hereby certify that we have fully and fairly canvassed the returns of said election, according to law, and as a result thereof we find One Hundred and Eighty-eight (188) were polled thereof, of which Seventy-eight (78) were in favor of the incorporation of said territory by the name of Thief River Falls and Fifty-two (52) in favor of the incorporation of said Territory under the name of Twin Falls, and that Forty-seven (47) votes were cast against said incorporation, and that Eleven (11) of the ballots at said election were improperly marked and not entitled to be counted for or against either of said propositions; that as a result of said election and our said canvass of said returns, we hereby certify that said territory is created, organized and incorporated as a City by the name of Thief River Falls, with a population of between Eleven Hundred (1100) and Two Thousand (2000), and we hereby further certify that we have caused to be made and have attached hereto, a correct map of said territory so incorporated.
