Pursuant to the provisions of M.S.A. 414.033 Subd. 5 your Petitioners respectfully represent:

That they are all the owners of the following described parcel of property situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of 13th Street and the North-South Quarter line in Section Twenty-eight (28), Township One Hundred Fifty-four (154) North, Range Forty-three (43) West; thence South along the North-South quarter line to the southerly line of Nelson-Hess Addition; thence northwesterly along the southerly line of said Nelson-Hess Addition to the easterly right-of-way line of the Burlington Northern Railroad; thence northwesterly along said right-of-way line to the centerline of 13th Street extended; thence East along said centerline to the point of beginning; containing 16.4 acres more or less.
