RESOLUTION

At a regular meeting of the City Council held March 23, 19 71.
Alderman Narverud seconded by Alderman Engelstad introduced the
following resolution and moved its adoption:

ORDINANCE NO. 366
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE
CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS

The City Council of the Thief River Falls do hereby ordain as
follows:

Section 1.

WHEREAS, all of the owners of the following described premises
situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of 13th
Street and the North-South Quarter line in Section Twenty-
eight (28), Township One Hundred Fifty-four (154) North,
Range Forty-three (43) West; thence South along the North-
South Quarter line to the Southerly line of Nelson-Hess
Addition; thence Northwesterly along the Southerly line
of said Nelson-Hess Addition to the Easterly right-of-way
line of the Burlington Northern Railroad; thence Northwesterly
along said right-of-way line to the centerline of 13th Street
extended; thence East along said centerline to the point of
beginning; containing 16.4 acres more or less.

have petitioned to the City Council to have such land included within
the municipality and have filed copies of said petition with the
Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, with the Town Board of
the Township of North and with the County Board of the County of
Pennington, State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the above described property abuts upon the boundaries
of the City of Thief River Falls, and

WHEREAS, NO OBJECTIONS TO THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION HAVE BEEN
SUBMITTED,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby determined that the annexation
of said premises will be to the best interest of the City of Thief River
Falls and of the territory affected and the above described premises are
hereby declared annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its
passage, approval, publication and filing with the Municipal Commission,
the Town Clerk, the Pennington County Auditor and the Secretary of State
of the State of Minnesota.



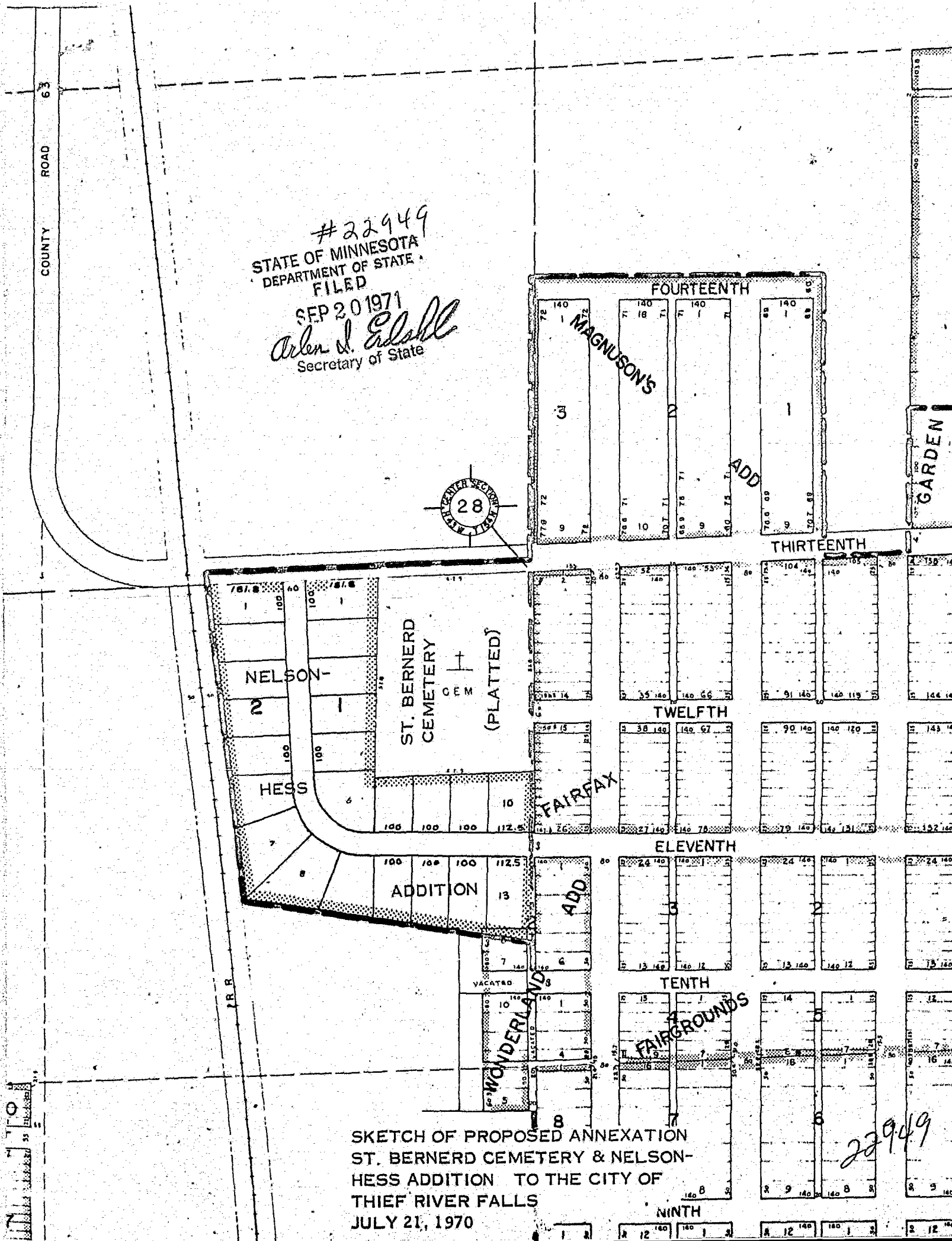
