

**ORDINANCE NO. 173
AN ORDINANCE DECLARING
CERTAIN LAND ANNEXED
TO THE VILLAGE OF
RUSH CITY, MINNESOTA.**

The Village Council of Rush City, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION I.

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Annotated 414.033 the following described real estate located in Chisago County, Minnesota, is hereby annexed to the Village of Rush City, Minnesota:

That part of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter (S 1/2 of SE 1/4) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-one (21), described as: Beginning at a point 460.5 feet east and 330 feet north of the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW 1/4 of SE 1/4), Section Sixteen (16), which is the point of the beginning of the parcel to be described; thence North 378 feet; thence east at right angles to the east line of said SW 1/4 of SE 1/4; thence south at right angles to a point directly east of the point of beginning; thence west at right angles to the point of beginning.

SECTION II.

This ordinance becomes effective from and after its adoption and publication and upon filing a copy of the Ordinance with the Municipal Commission, State of Minnesota; the Township Clerk of Rushseba Township; the County Auditor of Chisago County, Minnesota; and the Secretary of State of Minnesota.
