

At a regular meeting of the city council of the city of Hastings, March 12th, 1894 at 7:30 P. M.; the entire council present, to-wit: Aldo Krueger, Sommers, Gaus, Bailey, Sondernman, Gergen Smith, Tuttle and Westerson, Mayor Heinen presiding; Ald Gergen introduced an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to Adopt the Provisions of Chapter Two Hundred and Four (204) of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1893," which was read the first time. On motion of Ald Gergen the ordinance was passed to its second reading by the following vote: Aldo Krueger, Sommers, Gaus, Bailey, Sondernman, Gergen, Tuttle, Westerson and Mayor Heinen voting in the affirmative and Ald Smith voting in the negative. On motion of Ald Sommers the rules were suspended and the ordinance was read a third time and adopted by the following vote: Aldo Krueger, Sommers, Gaus, Bailey, Sondernman, Gergen, Tuttle, Westerson and Mayor Heinen voting in the affirmative and Ald Smith in the negative. The ordinance was then, on motion of Ald Gergen passed by the following vote: Ald Krueger, Sommers, Gaus, Bailey, Sondernman, Gergen, Tuttle, Westerson, and Mayor Heinen voting in the affirmative and Ald Smith in the negative.

An Ordinance to Accept the Provisions of Chapter Two Hundred and Four (204) of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1893.

The Council of the City of Hastings Do Ordain :--

Section One :--- That the City of Hastings hereby subjects itself and becomes subject to and adopts as part of the City Charter of said city, the provisions of that certain act of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota entitled " An Act to Grant Additional Powers to Cities of the State of Minnesota, and to Empower such Cities to Issue their Bonds for Certain Purposes therein mentioned ", approved April 12th., 1893, being Chapter Two Hundred and Four (204) of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893.

Section Two :--- This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
