Ordinance No. 41.

An ordinance relating to the adoption of Chapter 204 of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893 relating to the issuing of bonds.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of New Ulm:

That the City of New Ulm, Brown Co. Minnesota, does hereby adopt and become subject to the provisions of Chapter 204 of the General Laws of Minnesota for the year 1893, said Chapter 204 being an act entitled, "An act to grant additional powers to cities of the State of Minnesota and to empower such cities to issue their bonds for certain purposes therein mentioned," in lieu and in place of the provisions of the charter of said city relating to the issuing of bonds.

The said Chapter 204 of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893, be and the same is hereby adopted and made one of the provisions of the City Charter of said city of New Ulm and all bonds hereafter issued by said city for the municipal purposes, provided for in said act, shall be issued subject to and in the manner provided in said Chapter 204 of the General Laws aforesaid and not otherwise.
