ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LINDSTROM, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated March 15, 1971, requesting annexation of certain territory was duly presented to the Council on the 22nd day of March, 1971, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately 16 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all of the owners of the land proposed to be annexed^x as hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the Village limits at the northerly boundary thereof; and

WHEREAS, copies of said Petition have been filed with the Municipal Commission, the Town Board of the Town of Chisago Lake, and the Chisago County Board of County Commissioners, said Town and County being the Town and County in which all of the land proposed to be annexed is located, and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of no other municipality abut upon the boundaries of the land to be so annexed, and

WHEREAS, no written objections to said annexation have been submitted to the Municipal Commission or the Village of Lindstrom by the Chisago Lake Town Board or the Chisago County Board of Commissioners within sixty (60) days after said filing and the time allowed pursuant to law, and

WHEREAS, no petition for incorporation or annexation is pending before the Municipal Commission including all or any part of the land proposed to be annexed and herein described.

The Council of the Village of Lindstrom ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines

(1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village Limits and is urban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any incorporated city, village or borough and is unplatted, and does not exceed 200 acres.

Section 2: Territory annexed, The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village as affectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

All that part of Government Lot Six (6), Section Thirty-four (34), Township Thirty-four (34) North, Range Twenty (20) West, Chisago County, Minnesota; all that part of Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), and Four (4), Block One (1) of the recorded plat of Andrew's Beach, Chisago County, Minnesota, and all that part of the 33-foot alley in the West side of said recorded plat of Andrew's Beach; described jointly as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Government Lot 6, Section 34, Thence Southerly, along the West line thereof, 429 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing Southerly, along the said West line, 837.7 feet to a point distant 33 feet North of the Southwest corner of said Government Lot 6 which point is also on the West line of said recorded plat of Andrew's Beach; thence deflecting 90° 16' Easterly from said West line, a distance of 869 feet to the point of intersection thereof with the East line of said Lot 4, Block 1 of Andrew's Beach, which point is distant 251.6 feet Northerly of the Southeast corner of said Lot 4; thence deflecting 89° 44' Northerly, along said East line and the Northerly extension thereof, a distance of 238.6

feet; thence deflecting 91°58' Westerly, a distance of 5 feet; thence deflecting 87° 34' Northerly, a distance of 625 feet to the point of intersection thereof with a line drawn parallel with and distant 429 feet South of the North line of said Government Lot 6; thence Westerly, along said parallel line, 816.4 feet to the point of beginning and excepting therefrom the 245.5 foot portion of the platted 33-foot alley along the West line of Lot 1, Block 1 of Andrew's Beach, which portion lies within the above described tract, said tract, exclusive of the alley, contains 16.0 acres, more or less, except all that part of Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), and Four (4), Block One (1) of the recorded plat of Andrew's Beach, Chisago County, Minnesota.

Also including the alley in Government Lot 6 lying West of Lot 1.


Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor of Chisago County, Minnesota.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3.
