(2) Said newspaper is published at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news items of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality of Shakopee, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three days in arrears. (5) Said newspaper has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (6) Said newspaper serves the City of Shakopee in the County of Scott and it has its known office in said county, established and open during its regular hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions. (7) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State. (8) Said newspaper is a legal newspaper.

ORDINANCE NO. 45  
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PERMANENT  
REGISTRATION OF QUALIFIED VOTERS IN THE VILLAGE OF  
SAVAGE.

The Council of the Village of Savage ordains:  
Section 1. REGISTRATION SYSTEM ADOPTED. The system for the permanent registration of voters provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 201, is hereby adopted for the Village of Savage.  
Section 2. VOTERS MUST BE REGISTERED. No person shall be permitted to vote at any election in the Village of Savage unless he is registered as provided by Minnesota Statutes.  
Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication; except that the requirements herein adopted shall not apply to any election held prior to November 2, 1971.
