SAVAGE. The Council of the Village of Savage ordains: Section 1. REGISTRATION SYSTEM ADOPTED. The system for the permanent registration of voters provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 201, is hereby adopted for the Village of Savage. Section 2. VOTERS MUST BE REGISTBRED. No person shall be permitted to vote at any election in the Village of Savage unless he is registered as provided by Minnesota Statutes. Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication; except that the requirements herein adopted shall not apply to any elec-tion held prior to November 2, 1971.
