WHEREAS, it is the desire of the undersigned to establish a tradition of proudly displaying works of Minnesota History publicly in the governor's residence; and


WHEREAS, the library has a considerable monetary value which will increase through the years; and




NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that this letter of agreement shall be filed with the Secretary of State, together with a list of the books so presented;


be it further resolved that this agreement shall apply to the present library of seventy-five volumes and any additions which may subsequently be made.



While this Letter of Agreement is considered by this office to be binding, it has somewhat less than the effect of a formal document.


