- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Historical Society has presented to the governor's residence a library on Minnesota History; and
- WHEREAS, this library is presented for enjoyment and edification of the governor, his family and guests; and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the undersigned to establish a tradition of proudly displaying works of Minnesota History publicly in the governor's residence; and
- WHEREAS, the library has a considerable monetary value which will increase through the years; and
- WHEREAS, it is the understanding of the undersigned that this library, presented by the Minnesota Historical Society to the governor's residence and thus to the people of the State of Minnesota, shall remain at the official residence of the governor.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that this letter of agreement shall be filed with the Secretary of State, together with a list of the books so presented;

be it further resolved that if at some future date a governor should choose not to maintain the library display at the governor's residence then the library shall be promptly returned to the custody of the director of the Minnesota Historical Society and

be it further resolved that this agreement shall apply to the present library of seventy-five volumes and any additions which may subsequently be made.
