AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS INTO
THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMBURG

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Hamburg has determined that certain lands in the Town of Young America are bordered by the corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg on more than 60 per cent of their perimeter, and that said lands, as provided by Minnesota Statutes Section 414.033 may be annexed by Ordinance of the Village of Hamburg unless objections thereto are filed within 60 days of receipt by the Town of Young America of a Notice as provided by said Section 414.033; and

WHEREAS, such Notice was served upon the Town Clerk of the Town of Young America on the 19th. day of Nov., 1970, and more than sixty (60) days have passed since such service and no objections thereto have been filed by the Town of Young America or any other party:

The Village Council of the Village of Hamburg, Carver County, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below is bordered by the corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg on more than 60 per cent of its perimeter; that said lands are not now included in any other municipality; that said lands are conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government; and that annexation of said lands would be in the best interests of the Village of Hamburg and of the territory to be annexed.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg are hereby extended to encompass and embrace all of the territory described as follows, to wit:-

That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-two (32), Township One Hundred Fifteen (115), Range Twenty-six (26), described as follows:
Commencing at a point on the North line of said Section at a distance of 153 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet West of the Northeast Corner of said Section; thence running South a distance of 214 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a point; thence running West a distance of 100 feet to a point; thence running North a distance of 214 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the North line of said Section; thence running East a distance of 100 feet, to the place of beginning, containing 50/100 acres of land/ more or less.

Section III. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and the Auditor of Carver County.

Section IV. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be deemed final upon the filing of the copies of this Ordinance as directed in Section III and publication as provided by law.
