ORDINANCE NO. 64

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARIES OF
THE VILLAGE OF HAMBURG, MINNESOTA, AND
INCORPORATE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY THEREIN

WHEREAS, the Village of Hamburg has previously acquired the land hereinafter described and is the owner thereof; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute Section 414.033 provides that land which is owned by a municipality may be annexed by Ordinance without further proceedings,

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMBURG, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section I. DECLARATION. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts the present corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg; that said lands are not now included in any other municipality; that said lands are urban in character; and that said lands are owned by the Village of Hamburg.

Section II. TERRITORY ANNEXED. The corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg are hereby extended to encompass and embrace all of the territory described as follows, to wit:

Tract A: Commencing at the intersection of the center line of Louisa Street extended and the Northerly line of Sofia Street in the Village of Hamburg, Carver County, Minnesota; thence on an assumed bearing of North 53° 51' West along the said Northerly line of Sofia Street for a distance of 115.45 feet; thence on a bearing of North 89° 20' West along the North line of Sofia Street for a distance of 114.00 feet; thence on a bearing of North 0° 00' East parallel with the West line of Section 28, T. 115N, R. 26W, for a distance of 110.00 feet to the actual point of beginning of the following described tract; thence on a bearing of North 89° 20' West parallel with the said North line of Sofia Street for a distance of 100.00 feet; thence on a bearing of North 0° 22' 22" East for a distance of 293.40 feet; thence on a bearing of South 78° 46' East for a distance of 100.00 feet; thence on a bearing of South 0° 00' West parallel with the said West line of Section 28 for a distance of 275.08 feet to the actual point of beginning. This tract contains 0.65 acres of land.

Tract B: Commencing at the intersection of the center line of Louisa Street extended and the Northerly line of Sofia Street in the Village of Hamburg, Carver County, Minnesota; thence on an assumed bearing of North 36° 09' East along the center line of Louisa Street extended for a distance of 447.00 feet to the actual point of beginning of the following described tract; thence continuing on a bearing of North 36° 09' East along the center line of Louisa Street extended for a distance of 75.72 feet; thence on a bearing of North 38° 21' West for a distance of 300.00 feet; thence on a bearing of South 66° 46' 24" West for a distance of 465.11 feet; thence on a bearing of South 78° 46' East for a distance of 580.00 feet to the actual point of beginning. This tract contains 2.00 acres of land.

Section III. FILING. The Village Clerk is hereby instructed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, the Auditor of Carver County, and the Town Clerk of the town of Young America.

Section IV. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ANNEXATION. Annexation shall be deemed final upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section III above.
