

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota, to Include Certain Unincorporated Platted Land and Unplatted Land Not Exceeding 200 Acres in Area Abutting Upon the Village Limits.

WHEREAS, a certain petition was filed with the Village Clerk to be presented to the Village Council on March 17, 1971, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately 130 acres of platted and unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the original petition was signed by 46 owners, constituting a majority but not all of a total number of 73 owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received by the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was duly held by the governing body of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota on the proposed annexation after at least 30 days posted notice; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the Village limits at the North Boundary thereof;

The Council of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described therein abuts upon the Village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the platted and unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

(a) Platted: I. Plat of Elm Acres, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota. II. Plat of Elm Park, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota. III. Plat of McKinney Lake Addition, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota.

(b) Unplatted: I. Government Lot One (1) of Section Seventeen (17), Township Fifty-five North (55N.) of Range Twenty-five (25), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota. II. Government Lot One (1), of Section Sixteen (16), Township Fifty-five North (55N.) of Range Twenty-five (25), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota. III. Part of Government Lot Two (2), Section Sixteen (16), Township Fifty-five North (55N.) of Range Twenty-five (25), West of the Fourth Principal Meridian lying West of Highway No. 38, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Itasca County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
