ORDINANCE NUMBER 123
VILLAGE OF FOLEY
BENTON COUNTY MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated June 1, 1971, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 1st day of June, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land appraised within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately 1 acre of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all of the owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the Village Limits;

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOLEY MINNESOTA ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

That the 1967 Code of Ordinances of the Village of Foley be amended by adding Section 100:07 to read as follows:

Section 100:07 (1).

The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village and to the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village Limits and is suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 100:07 (2) Territory Annexed.

The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The West 250 feet of the East 561 feet of the South 165 feet of the North 198 feet of the Southeast Quarter of Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$), of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Thirty-seven (37) North, Range Twenty-nine (29) West, Fourth Principal Meridian, except the land taken by the State of Minnesota for the relocation of Trunk Highway 218, now Trunk Highway 25, all of said property being situated in the County of Benton and State of Minnesota.

Section 100:07 (3) Filing.

The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Municipal Commission, Secretary of State, County Auditor, and the Clerk of the Gilmanton Township Board.

Section 100:07 (4) Effective Date.

This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 100:07 (3).

Passed and adopted at the regular meeting of the Village Council on the 7th day of September, 1971 by unanimous vote of all members present.
