HUGO, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA 55038

Ordinance No. 73

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HUGO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED AND UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA AND ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated December 7, 1970, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 7th day of December 1970; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 75 acres of unplatted land; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners of the land; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the Village limits at the SOUTHEAST boundary thereof;

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HUGO ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village limits and is about to become urban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The North one-half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 31, Range 21, according to the United States Government Survey thereof, except that part of the above described property as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 31 Range 21; thence North along the East line of said section a distance of 20 rods; thence West a distance of 40 rods; thence South a distance of 20 rods to the Southerly line of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter; thence East along said line a distance of 40 rods to the point of beginning, and containing 5 acres, more or less.

to the Village of Hugo, Minnesota and to extend the Village boundaries to include the same,

SECTION 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor of Washington County,

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
