PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: Harold Schoelkopf has earned the respect and gratitude of many people during his editorial career of almost 49 years with the St. Cloud Daily Times, and

WHEREAS: The record shows 27 years on the St. Cloud Board of Education, 22 years as a member of the St. Cloud Charter Commission, four years on City Council, four years on the Stearns County draft board, three years on the Little Hoover Commission, two years on the Governor's Committee on Penal Reform and two years on the Governor's Committee on Teacher Supply, and

WHEREAS: During this time, Harold Schoelkopf has left his name on some 20 school buildings which he helped plan and construct, and

WHEREAS: He presented diplomas to nine classes of high school graduates, including three to his son and two daughters, in his official capacity as chairman of the school board, and

WHEREAS: It must be acknowledged that Harold Schoelkopf is a most remarkable citizen and good neighbor of the St. Cloud community,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, October 1, 1971 as

"HAROLD SCHOELKOPF DAY"

in Minnesota, and urge all his friends to honor this man who has had a career unique in Minnesota history and has brought great credit to himself and the community he has served for a half century.
