PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: This state and nation owe a special debt of gratitude to veterans who have returned home after having served their country so well; and

WHEREAS: Many of those veterans are having a difficult time finding meaningful employment; and

WHEREAS: Throughout Minnesota, Jobs for Veterans Committees are being organized to encourage business and industry to hire returning veterans; and

WHEREAS: The President of the United States has called upon the National Alliance of Businessmen to assist these Jobs for Veterans Committees by asking business and industry to pledge 100,000 jobs for returning veterans; and

WHEREAS: The National Alliance of Businessmen has agreed to conduct a campaign during October to accomplish this purpose; and

WHEREAS: The local offices of the National Alliance of Businessmen are cooperating fully with the Jobs for Veterans Committee appointed by me and with other Jobs for Veterans Committees formed throughout our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim October, 1971, as

"JOBS FOR VETERANS MONTH"

and call upon all of our citizens to make a special effort during October to provide the employment opportunities which our returning veterans so deservedly have earned.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and of the State, the one hundred fourteenth.
