WHEREAS: the accomplishments and achievements of these young citizens deserve recognition and pride of their elders; and

WHEREAS: Optimist International has for the past 17 years developed and promoted a program entitled Youth Appreciation Week, this year to be observed November 8 - 14; and

WHEREAS: President Richard Nixon has signed into being Public Law 92-43 proclaiming November 8 - 14 as National Youth Appreciation Week; and

WHEREAS: the citizens of Minnesota have indicated a desire to join with the optimists in expressing appreciation and approval of the contributions of the youth.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 8 - 14, 1971, as
