ORDINANCE NO. 97.

An Ordinance Adopting and Making the City Subject to the Provisions of Chapter 233 of the Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1895.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE City of Faribault do ordain:

SECTION 1. The City of Faribault does hereby become subject to the provisions of an act of the legislature of the State of Minnesota, approved April 15, 1895, the same being Chapter 233 of the Laws of Minnesota for the year 1895.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its publication.
