

ORDINANCE NO. 73.

An ordinance submitting to the electors of the Village of Morris, Minnesota, the question whether said Village of Morris and the territory therein embraced, shall become incorporated into the City of Morris, under and subject to the provision of Chapter 8 General Laws of Minnesota 1895 and the acts amendatory thereof.

Section 1. The Common Council of the Village of Morris, does hereby ordain that on Tuesday the 20th day of October A. D. 1903, that there shall be held a special election in and for the Village of Morris, Minnesota, at which election the question will be submitted to the qualified voters of said Village, whether said Village shall become incorporated under and subject to the provision of Chapter 8 General Laws of the State of Minnesota 1895 and the acts amendatory thereof.

Section 2. That at said date and said election the question be submitted to the qualified voters of the said Village of Morris, Minnesota, whether said Village and the territory therein embraced become re-incorporated as the City of Morris under and subject to Chapter 8 General Laws of the State of Minnesota 1895 and the acts amendatory thereof.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
